Taste Like

So unique, so delicious!

Primošten vineyards are the place of origin of the **babić** variety. This area is known for its specific growing conditions such as poor soil, lots of sun and little water. **Bucavac**, the largest vineyard site, is a protected landscape. As a timeless testimony to the dedicated effort to steal a handful of earth from hard stone, **Bucavac** is both a monument to tradition and an active vineyard. The most recent **babić** vineyards are also exposed to the sun on the crushed rocks of the **Jadrtovac** site. A little further north, a mixture of continental and Mediterranean climate brings different winds. While the unbearable heat along the coast does not subside even at night, cool summer mornings are characteristic for areas in the Skradin hinterland and near **Plastovo**. A little further east, new winds again... hot summers and cold and windy winters shape the area around the town of **Drniš** and **Promina** vineyards. The specific soil and microclimate of **Promina** produce the grape that has nourished many generations of authentic Dalmatia.

Babić

The **babić** phenomenon is embodied in the belief that nothing grows from rock as well as **babić**. As a true child of the Mediterranean, it can survive on the top of the Greben hill or in the salty barrens of **Bucavac**. All it needs are two handfuls of earth. But not just any kind. **Babić** is considered an autochthonous variety of the **Šibenik** region. In general, it embodies all the prerequisites for producing great red Dalmatian wine. Quality extract, full body, mild tannins, fruitiness, freshness and suppleness, even during the driest years. The most successful examples of **babić** are persistent on the palate with an intensity that does not fade, often reminiscent of the **marasca** cherry.

Plavina

Due to its microclimate characteristics and long tradition, **plavina** achieves excellent results in the vineyards of **Šibenik-Knin** County. **Plavina** wine is soft and refreshing, and due to its less pronounced astringency, you can drink it young, but it also ages beautifully. It has milder tannins, medium body and medium alcohol content. This harmonious wine with delicate fruit aromas of Mediterranean character is easily paired with a number of different dishes, especially the traditional cuisine of the **Šibenik** region. **Plavina** achieves success both as a dry still red or rose wine, and even as a base for sparkling wine.

Lasina

Lasina is a somewhat endemic variety present mainly in the vineyards around **Plastovo** and **Drniš**, a real rarity among the red wines of Dalmatia. As supple, medium-bodied red wine with low tannins, **lasina** achieves an almost silky smooth texture. Such an unusual variety requires specific conditions such as those in the **Šibenik** hinterland to succeed. A wine of fresh, fruity character tending toward red berries that resembles continental wine in structure. **Lasina** is always a curiosity. The number of wineries that grow and produce red or rose wine from **lasina** is increasing.

Drniški merlot

Merlot is one of the most widespread noble grape varieties in the world, and it has a special character when it grows in the **Drniš** region. Depending on the composition of the soil in each vineyard, as well as viticultural practice, those grapes are used to produce "juicy and fruity" refreshing wines or "fleshy and fat" strong red wines. Lower yields, higher concentration and full ripeness of grapes at the best vineyard sites of **Drniš** and **Promina** are reflected in a full-bodied, rich wine with a very pleasant and harmonious taste. Specific aromatic profile intensifies depending on the age of the wine, and is characterised by blue and black berries, herbal sensations and minerality. Given the long-term presence of **merlot** and the specific climate in which it grows, today this **merlot** is rightly called **Drniški merlot**.

Debit

This is the most widespread variety in **Šibenik-Knin** County. The modern interpretation of **debit** wines demonstrates qualities that are not easily achieved in Dalmatia: freshness and suppleness, pleasant fullness and lower alcohol content. Thanks to its naturally harmonious acidity and specific fruity character, **debit** pairs perfectly with Adriatic white fish. Dry white wine with a refreshing character.

Maraština

Maraština is synonymous with quality white wines from the rich viticultural past of the **Šibenik** region. The return of tradition and its renown is once again achieved in the wines of **Šibenik-Knin** County. Many winemakers have recognised the potential of this variety that regularly achieves optimal oenological parameters and is therefore suitable for producing structured white wines. From young dry wines to **prosecco**, **maraština** is always aromatic in the floral-fruity spectrum. This aroma is best expressed after a certain time of aging in the bottle, when **maraština** shows its full potential. **Maraština** often produces golden-yellow middle to full-bodied wines with higher alcohol content, which is why it is suitable for pairing even with structured, rich dishes.
